Team 1: CLEANING & CONSERVATION TEAM

1. River and spring-cleaning in the school neighborhood.

1. River Cleaning Drive

- Collect plastic waste, bottles, wrappers.
- Separate biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste.
- Dispose of waste properly.
- Record the amount of waste collected.

2. Spring Cleaning Activity

- Remove fallen leaves and waste around the spring.
- Clean the surrounding area.
- Put up “Do Not Litter” signs.
- Plant small trees or plants near the spring to protect soil.

Team 2: ARTISTIC INCLUSION & AWARENESS TEAM

This team will spread awareness through creative arts working with students with special needs.

1. Chalkboard Drawing Activity

Theme:

- “Save Water”
- “Water is Life”
- “Protect Our Rivers”

Activities:

- Create eco-themed chalk drawings in school.
- Write water-saving slogans.
- Display top drawings on the school notice board.

2. Clay Work (Model Making)

Activities:

- Make clay models of:
 - A clean river vs polluted river.
 - A water cycle model.
 - A protected spring.
- Create clay slogan plates like:
 - “Save Every Drop”
 - “Think Blue, Go Green”
- Display models during school exhibition.

Team 3:

Puppet Show – “The Crying River”

Story Idea:

- A river character (puppet) cries because people throw garbage.
- A group of children promise to clean and protect it.
- Message: “If you protect water, water protects you.”

Puppet Show Activities:

- Make puppets using paper bags and cloth.
- Write a short script (5–7 minutes).
- Practice voice modulation and expressions.
- Perform during assembly or community event.
